Christ is our intercessor

As part of a special agreement with "A | He never lives to intercede for them." (Jews 7:25) Dear friend, we can look back at the time when the Lord Jesus died on the Cross as our Savior. We can look forward to the time when he returns to this land to govern and reign as our next king. In this lesson we are going to consider the current Ministry of the Lord Jesus as our Intercessor. Jesus is our intercessor What is the Lord Jesus doing now? He prays for us. The Bible tells us that Jesus is our great intercessor. An intercessor is the one who prays for another. And this is just what the Lord Jesus is doing now. He is in heaven to pray for all those who believe in him. There have been many great men of the Bible who prayed for others. They interceded to God for their people. Sometimes they asked God to forgive the sins of their people, and sometimes asked God to deliver their people from the enemies of him. These men were intercessors because they prayed to God for others. We need an intercessor too. Why? Because we have a great enemy, Satan, who hates every son of God. Even if Satan can take us out of the family of God, we do everything possible to make us sin. He tries to prevent us from living a life that God like. But we must not be afraid because the Lord Jesus is our great intercessor. He prays for us every day. The Bible says: "Christ is ϵ | Entured ϵ | Into heaven itself, to appear now in the presence of God for us." Hebrews 9:24 The great men of the Bible who prayed for their people eventually died. Death is concluded their prayers. The Lord Jesus also died, but it is risen! He is alive today, and which is continually praying for those who belong to him. The Bible says: "A | He never lives to intercede for them." Hebrews 7:25 The Lord Jesus is the perfect intercessor when the Lord Jesus was here on Earth, he often prayed for his disciples. He loved them, and he prayed that they could be held by evil. The Lord Jesus is in heaven now, and continues to pray for those who belong to him. He is the perfect intercessor for us. There are three reasons why Jesus is the perfect intercessor for us: 1. He is the favorite son of God. 2. He understands us perfectly. 3. He paused our sins. We think of these three things. Jesus is the favorite son of God. There is nothing that God the Father will not do for his son delight. The Bible says: "The father loves his son and gave him everything in his hand." (John 03:35) Jesus told his disciples to pray to his father in the name of him. He said: " \grave{A} ϵ | Whatsoever you ask the father in my name, he will give you to you." (John 16:23) Jesus understands us perfectly. Do you know why the Lord Jesus understands perfectly? Because he himself lived here as a man. The Bible says it was necessary that Jesus to be like us, so that he could be our merciful and faithful high priest (intercessor) before God. The Lord Jesus knows what it means to be poor and being hungry. He knows what it means to be rejected and misunderstood. He knows what it means to be tempted and persecuted. There is nothing that can happen to us that he does not understand. The Bible says he "was attempted in everything like us, excluding sin". Jews 4:15 because Jesus himself was through suffering and temptation, he knows what he means when he suffers and tempted. He is the perfect intercessor for us because he understands us perfectly. Jesus paid the penalty for our sins. The Lord Jesus has the right to be our intercessor because he paid the penalty of our sins. The nails signs in the hands and feet and the press of the spear in the cost of him remember the fact that he died on the cross for ours When we join, Jesus can point to the signs of the nails in his hands and saying: "Father, I know this has sin, but I paid for his sins. I bought him with my own blood. He belongs to me." God can forgive, because Jesus paid the penalty of our sins. What is Jesus as how intercessor? We saw that the Lord Jesus is the perfect intercessor for us. Now we think of three ways in which the Lord Jesus intercedes for us. 1. Prays for us when we are tempted. 2. Intercede for us when we sin. 3. He presents our prayers to his father. Consider these things. Christ prays for us when we are tempted. The Lord Jesus prays above all that we will not give up to sin when we are tempted by Satan. He prayed to his father, "I don't pray that you should take them out of the world, but that you should keep them from evil [from the evil, Satan]." John 17:15 As long as we are in this world, we will be tempted. But the Lord Jesus is praying for us, and the Father promised that he would not allow us to be tried beyond our power to resist. He will always make a way of fleeing for us. The Bible says: " \grave{A} ϵ \grave{a} , ~ | \grave{A} ϵ \grave{a} , ~ | \grave{d} is faithful, which does not suffer from [allow] that you are attempted above to be able; but with the temptation also make a way to Flee, you may be able to bear it." 1 Corinthians 10:13 means that we can't sin? No not at all. We can sin, but we must not sin. We can say "no!" At temptation. Christ intercede for us when we sin. When we received Christ as our Savior, we were born in the God's family. We have a new relationship with God. It is our Heavenly Father, and we are children. Whatever this relationship can break? No, our relationship with God as son of him can never be broken. But there is another question that is very important to us as children of God, and this is our communion with our Heavenly Father. What does "Fellowship" mean with others? It means we like to be with them. We love them, and we know they love us. We like to talk to them and share our joys and tests with them. God loves us and he wants to have communion with him. He wants us to have fun with him. He wants him to tell him of our joys and evidence. God wants him to love him and know that he loves us. When we obeyed for him, we like the wonderful phrase with him. Can this communication be broken? Yes, he can. What broke? SIN! When we seal, our communion with the father is broken. Our relationship with him as a son of him is not broken, but sin breaks our communion with him. Can our communion with the father be restored? Yes, he can. Who restores it? The Lord Jesus! Intercede for us when we sin. The Bible says: "If a pily man, we have a lawyer [an intercessor] with his father, Jesus Christ the righteous". 1 John 2: 1 The Lord Jesus declares you when we sinful. He asked the father to forgive ourselves for the good of him. It is because of those who are Jesus and what he did for us that God forgives us of our sins. The Bible says: " \grave{A} ϵ \grave{a} \grave{a} | The sins are forgiven for the name of him." 1 John 2:12 God not only forgives us, but it cleans us with the precious blood of Christ who could still have a communion with him. When is our communion with God restored? Our company is restored when we confess our sins to the Father. The Bible says: "If we confess our sins, it is faithful and only to forgive our sins and to clean up from every injustice". 1 John 1: 9 means that we can decide to sin every day and then confess it to God and think that everything will be fine? No! No! No! If we are thinking in this way, we should examine us to see if we are really in the family of God. A true son of God will enjoy his heavenly Father, and odres the things that God hates. Christ presents our prayers to the Father. We have seen how the Lord Jesus prays for us when we are tempted and how he restores our communion with his father when we sin. But there is still something wonderful that the Lord Jesus is for us: he presents our prayers to his father. Many people think that anyone Praying God and that God will listen to and will answer their prayers, but this is not true. real. Those who have received the Lord Jesus as their Savior can pray to God as father. And we must pray in the name of Jesus if we want God to listen and answer our prayers. The Lord Jesus said, "Whatever you ask the Father in my name, I will give." John 16:23 When we pray the Lord Jesus is our great intercessor. He presents our prayers to the Father. He asks the Father to grant our requests to him well of him. It's because of who Jesus is and what He has done for us that God hears and answers our prayers. Through Christ we can come boldly to God in this lesson we have learned that the Lord Jesus is the perfect intercessor for us. He prays for us every day. He does not transform us when we need help, but he gives him the strength to him. He does not condemn us when we fail, but he is patient and merciful towards us. When we sin, He intercedes for us with the Father so that our communion with the Father can be restored. You are troubled by temptation you can not overcome? Then come to the Father through the Lord Jesus and ask him to give you victory over them. Have you sinned? Six out of the company with the Father? You lost your joy as a Christian? Then come to the Father through your great intercessor, the Lord Jesus Christ. Confess your sins to God and ask him to forgive you. The Lord Jesus will restore your fellowship with the Father. You have a great need? You are troubled by a problem in your life or in the lives of your loved ones? So pray to the Father in the name of Jesus. The Lord Jesus is the beloved child of God, and will present your prayers to the Father. The Bible says, "Seeing that we have a great priest priest [a great intercessor], which is transmitted in the heavens, Jesus the Son of Dio ϵ \grave{a} ~ | we are so bold to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need." Hebrews 4:14, 16 Only with God the secret of a strong Christian life is the" quiet time of the day. " This is a time spent alone with God in the study of the Word and in prayer for him. Here are some tips that will help you form the habit of a daily time. 1. Time and place Choose a good time for you. The early morning is the best time for most people. Pick a place where you can be alone. This might mean getting up in the morning before everyone else in the family. After choosing a time and a place, stick to them. 2. The Bible uses a Bible that has a good press and is easy to read. Have a plan for reading. First, read the Gospel of John. After you have finished John, begin with the Gospel of Matthew and read right through the entire Old Testament. As you open your Bible to read, first close your eyes and talk to God. Confess your sins; Ask Him to speak to your heart through the word of him as the laws. Remember that you are in his presence. 3. The prayer after reading and listening to God speak to your heart through word of him, take time to pray. Thanks for the word of him to you; Thanks for the blessings of him-he names them, one by one; Thank you for the blood of Jesus that cleanses us from all sin; Thank you for responding to your prayers; Thanks largely to the Lord Jesus, your Savior. You want to ask something? Tell him the desires of your heart. Listen to every request. Remember to pray for your family and friends. It's nice to make a list of those for whom you pray. Do you really know God? Then you must spend time alone with him. He.
