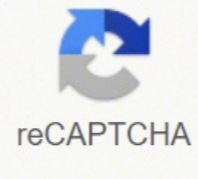

The Crucible Act II Figurative Language

Read aloud

Writers use figurative language for emphasis, clarity, precision or comparisons. Figurative language is "an economical way to get a point across." Arthur Miller employs several different figures of speech, helping his audience to understand the play on a deeper level. He frequently uses **parallel structure and repetition** to stress a character's needs and make it easier for actors to remember their lines; **similes and metaphors** provide fresh comparisons; **alliteration** (the repetition of beginning word sounds) and **onomatopoeia** (words imitate sounds) are called "sound devices" because they have an auditory appeal. **Personification** gives characteristics for the inanimate; **contrast** shows an oppositional relationship; **Biblical, mythological, and literary allusions** reference famous works; **synecdoche** describes a sense in terms of another sense, (I could take his name), and **symbolism** associates objects to ideas or principles. **Appearances** word play showing two different meanings of the same word or two words that sound alike, and **irony** suggests the opposite of what is expected or the contrary of the literal meaning. **Personification** gives human qualities to non-human things. Questions on Part One of Act Three of The Crucible by Arthur Miller ANSWER KEY

1. Why does Giles think that Putnam is accusing Cile's wife?

He says "Thomas Putnam is reaching out for land!" In other words, he believes that his wife is being accused because his neighbor wants their land.

2. Danforth says, "the entire contention of the state in these trials is that the voice of heaven is speaking through the children." Explain in your own words what he means when he says this and what the implications are for this decision.

What he means here is that all of the evidence for the trials comes from children. It also means that since the "state" believes that heaven is speaking through the children, their testimony has more weight than an average witness. This is sort of the opposite of a more normal trial, where a child would hardly be considered the expert witness.

3. What actions of Proctors are used against him?

He ripped the warrant and slammed the court when they came to arrest his wife, he hasn't come to church often, and he prays on Sunday.

4. How does Proctor try to defend the accused women?

He brings a statement to Rebecca, Martha Corey, and Elizabeth's character. Ninety one people have signed to say that they have never seen evidence that the women are involved in witchcraft.

5. What does Danforth mean when he says "This is a sharp time, now, a precise time—we no longer live in the dusky afternoon when evil mixed itself with good and beheld the world?" Explain in your own words.

Student answers will vary, but essentially his point is that good and evil and black and white. Someone can't be both or have some good and some evil.

6. What proof does Giles offer against Putnam?

He says that Putnam "is killing his neighbors for their land" because if they are executed, he is the only one who has the money to purchase the land that they give up. He also says that the father of one of the girls who spoke out against Jacobs in the trials was given "a fair gift of land."

7. Explain the argument between Giles and Danforth. What does Danforth want? Why does Giles refuse?
