Before being hired as a safety officer one is subjected to an interview. This particular interview is meant to let the interviewer know how well one understands about health and safety. It is always paramount to be well prepared to answer these questions. The ideal way of doing this is going through the common safety interview questions. These questions might not be exactly the same as the one that will be asked during the interview. But they give one insight on what will be asked. Here are the primary safety officer interview questions. Question 1. What is an emergency? Answer I. An emergency is when a situation that was not expected happens. This means that the particular situation was not foreseen and therefore it has happened as a surprise. Answer II. Emergencies are risky situations which put people at risk but happen when no one is not expecting. Such situations require to be handled as soon as possible so as to reduce or eliminate the risks. Question 2. What is work permit system? Answer I. This is a written document which provides permission to undertake a job by area in charge. This particular document can also be referred to as the written document issues by the area in charge to the performer giving authorization to undertake a particular job. Question 3. What is work at height? Answer I. Work at height is when workers work above the ground in a place where the height is considerable. Answer II. This is when the workers are working in an elevated level where there is a risk of falling. Question 4. What is confined space? Answer I. This is when one is working in a place where there is limited space. This means that the space available is not enough to move about as one wants. Answer II. Confined space is when a worker or workers are working in a place which is enclosed and there is no freedom to move around especially while one needs to carry long items. Question 5. What is excavation? Answer I. This is marking a tunnel or a hole through digging the ground. Excavation can be done by either by a person or a machine depending on the requirements or availability of the machineries. Question 6. What is scaffolding? Answer I. This is when a temporary platform which is constructed to support workers while working in a construction site. This is especially while working on high heights where the workers are unable to work from the ground. Question 7. What is sandblasting? Answer I. This is removing unwanted substances such as rust, scales, old prints or scales from the old surface using compressed air. The removal of these substances make the surface become as good as new and this plays an important role in making work more efficient. Question 8. What is LEL? Answer I. This is the minimum concentration of gasses, vapor and dust in air below which propagation of flame does not occur on contact with a source of ignition. Question 9. What is UEL? Answer I. This is the optimum proportion of gasses, vapor and dust in air above which proposal the flame does not occur on contact with a source of ignition. Question 10. What is manual handling? Answer I. Manual handling is when workers do not use any kind of machineries to perform different duties. The workers use their hands to carry different things especially the things which are not too heavy. Question 11. What is personal protective equipment? Answer I. This is the equipment that is specifically meant to enhance the safety of individual workers. The equipment is used by individual workers with an objective of enhancing their safety before using the equipment that is meant for collective safety. Question 12. What is a JSA? Answer I. This is the procedure of analyzing job for the specific purpose of making sure that all the hazards and developing are identified. Question 13. What are the duties of a safety officer? Answer I. A safety officer is responsible of checking whether all the HSE attributes are put in place. The officer needs to inspect the working places and ensure they are safe for the workers. Answer II. The safety officer is supposed to advice employers on the things they should do to ensure the safety of the workers is enhanced. Answer III. The safety officer is also the person who is responsible of making sure that the workers are able to enhance their own safety through being skilled and observing the various safety attributes. Question 14. What are the duties of a supervisor? Answer I. A supervisor is the person who oversees the duties of the junior officers to ensure they are working diligently. Answer II. A supervisor is responsible of ensuring that all the things that are required for workers to work properly are available. These include providing proper tools which do not put the workers at risk. One of the main accidents is tripping on things that might have left on the floor while they should have been kept somewhere else. Answer II. Things getting damaged when they come into contact with water or other substances that can easily cause damages. Answer III. Poor lighting usually causes people to trip on different things. Question 20. How do you care and maintain hand tools? Answer I. Ensure that the hand tools are properly cleaned after they have been used. Answer II. Question 22. What are the hazards in constructions? Answer I. Falling off from a high height is one of the main hazards in constructions. Answer II. An object falling on a worker is also a common hazard in construction. Answer III. Being tripped by objects placed on the ground is also a common construction hazard. Question 23. What are the general precautions in construction? Answer I. It is important to wear the right protection clothes while working in a construction site. Answer II. Use the tools as they are supposed to be especially the machineries. Answer III. Do not leave tools and construction materials on the ground unattended. Question 24. What are the safety precautions of scaffold? Answer I. Always ensure that the scaffold is strong enough and can support the necessary weight. Answer II. Wear the right protective clothes especially the ones that are supposed to hold one in place while on the scaffold. Question 25. What control measures are necessary in confined space? Answer I. Ensure there is space for air to enter to avoid suffocation. Answer II. Have a space for emergency exit in case of situations which might require leaving the space within the shortest time possible. Question 26. What are the safety rules while using ladders? Answer I. Ensure that the ladder is not slippery by ensuring there are no substances such as oil or water. Answer II. Give a brief note about fork lift truck. Answer I. A fork lift truck needs to be operated by a qualified person who knows how to operate it properly. It should also be positioned in a place where it will not cause any damages and where it has ample space to operate freely. The truck should be removed from the work place when it is not needed anymore. Question 28. What are the precautions of excavation? Answer I. Ensure that there is enough room for the excavation to be done properly. Answer II. Use supportive materials to ensure that the tunnel or hole does not collapse. Question 29. This is the discussion regarding safe work procedures, following of safety rules, job related hazards and the job related safety aspects. This type of talk plays an important role in ensuring all the safety attributes are in place prior to starting any project. Question 31. What are the different types of hazards? Answer I. Some of the most common types of hazards include; mechanical hazards, chemical hazards, electrical hazards, fire hazards, electrical hazards, pollution hazards and radiation hazards. Question 32. What are the different types of inspections? Answer I. There are 5 different types of inspections and they are; continuous inspection, periodic inspection, intermittent inspection, statutory inspection and special inspection. Question 33. What is safety management? Answer I. This is the act of science of getting the safety objectives of the industrial company and therefore come up with the things that should be put in place to ensure that the necessary safety attributes are put in place. Question 34. What is accident investigation? Answer I. This is trying to get all the facts about the accident that has happened to know what were the causes and also how to avoid future accidents. This investigation needs to be done as soon as possible after the accident has happened so as to take the necessary precaution measures. Question 35. How should an accident be reported? Answer I. To effectively report an accident it is paramount to include a number of details including; date, time, activity, what happened, the people involved, what did not go right, causes, the suggested corrective actions, the safety officer reporting, the project manager and the signatures of all the people who got the report about the accident. Question 36. What is the role of management in industrial safety? Answer I. The management is responsible of writing a safety policy to be issued against the workers, materials and machines. Answer II. Drafting a safety policy that is responsible of bringing management towards the various aspects in the workplace. Answer III. Distributing the safety policy to all the people involved in the workplace. Answer IV. Arranging for safety inspection which should be done once in every three months and arranging for safety audit which should be done once every year. Question 37. What are human factors that usually cause accidents? Answer I. There are a number of human factors that causes accidents and they include; carelessness, hurrying to increase production, laziness, lack of attention, lack of skills, being intoxicated and not using PPE. The safety officer might come up with an assortment of policies to enhance safety but it the responsibility of the workers to ensure that they avoid the various human factors to make sure that there are no accidents. Question 38. What is safety? Answer I. Safety is ensuring that people are not exposed to situations that can readily result to accidents or any kind of harm. This means that in workplaces where safety is enhanced there measures that are put in place to make sure that the people working there are not exposed to conditions that can lead to the people being hurt or harmed. Question 39. What is accident? Answer I. An accident is a situation which causes harm and happens unexpectedly. Accidents usually occur without the people affected knowing.
