
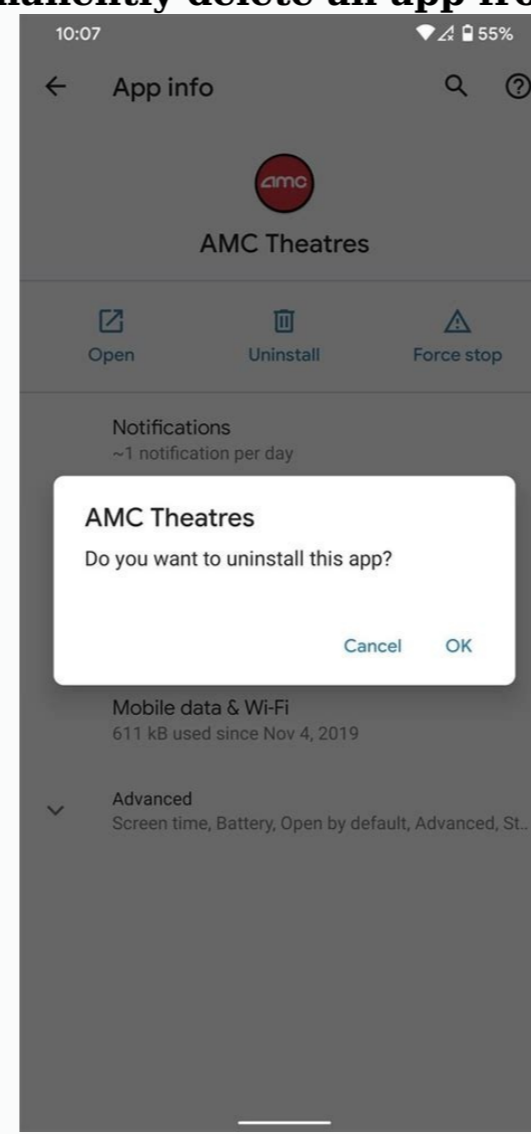

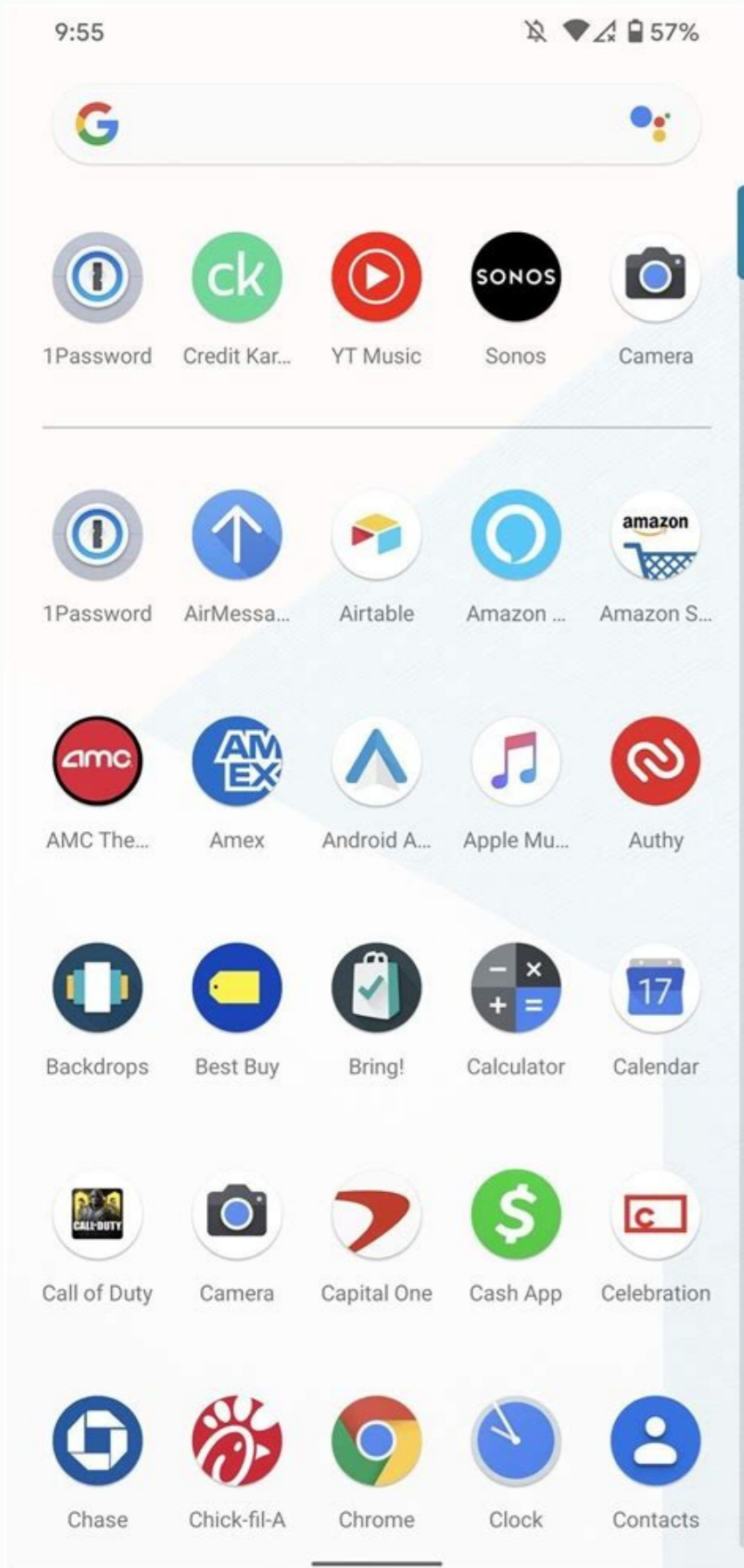

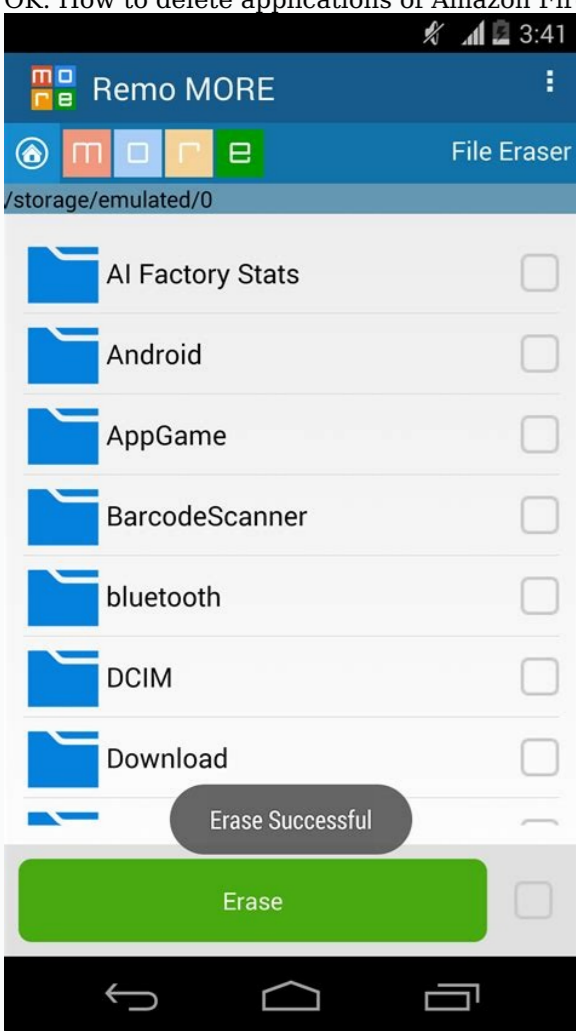
How do i permanently delete an app from my android.



If your Android device no longer has a free space, you may be wondering how you can remove apps from your phone. Uninstalling an app is a simple task that will not take long. In this article we take a detailed look at the various ways to uninstall apps on your Android device, how to remove system apps and much more. Let us dig now! Note from the editorial team. Some of the steps in this guide to remove Android apps were developed with a Google Pixel 7 with Android 13. Please note that the steps can vary depending on the hardware and software. 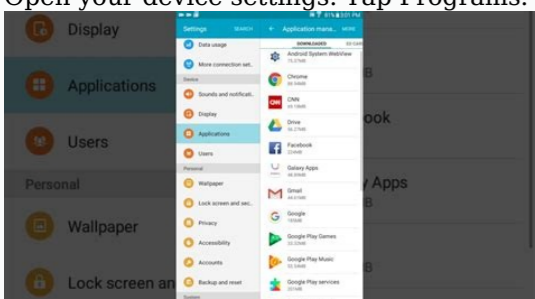

There are useful filters you can use on Google Play to sort the apps and find the ones you want to remove. If you are in Program and Device Management, there is an option that appears as "recently updated". Click on it and you can filter and sort according to names, most used, most used, recently updated, and sizes. The filter is used less frequently to remove old unused devices. If storage space is an issue, filtering according to size is the best choice. Open your phone settings and you will find that there is a way to access the full list of apps with a few taps. You can then click on the app and click on the Tly symbol or just the Tlube symbol next to the program to uninstall it so you can't just select multiple apps.
